
(Plaintiffs' Emergency Motion for Protective Order and/or Motion to Quash Subpoena

Pending before the court is Plaintiffs' Emergency Motion for Protective Order and/or Motion to Quash Subpoena for Deposition of Chevron Phillips Chemical Company (ECF No. 715). In view of Plaintiffs' Notice of Withdrawal of Emergency Motion for Protective Order and/or Motion to Quash Subpoena for Deposition of Chevron Phillips Chemical Company (ECF No. 719), the court hereby **DENIES** Plaintiffs' Motion for Protective Order and/or Motion to Quash as moot. It is so **ORDERED**.
