PRETRIAL ORDER #134

(Plaintiffs' Emergency Motion for Expedited Response to Motion to Compel)

Pending before the court is Plaintiffs' Emergency Motion for Expedited Response to Plaintiffs' Motion to Compel Responses from Defendant C.R. Bard, Inc. to Plaintiffs' Seventh and Eighth Requests for Production of Documents, (ECF No. 1027), and Defendant C.R. Bard, Inc.'s Response to same. (ECF No. 1030). Upon consideration, the court **GRANTS, in part,** and **DENIES, in part,** the motion. It is hereby **ORDERED** that Defendant C. R. Bard, Inc., shall file its brief in opposition to the motion to compel on or before **August 22, 2014**, and Plaintiffs shall file their reply brief on or before **August 26, 2014**. The undersigned United States Magistrate Judge shall conduct a telephonic hearing on the Motion to Compel Responses from Defendant C.R. Bard, Inc. to Plaintiffs' Seventh and Eighth Requests for Production of Documents, (ECF No. 1022), on **Friday, August 29, 2014 at 3:00 p.m.** The conference number required to connect to the telephonic hearing will be provided to counsel by the court.

The court **DIRECTS** the Clerk to file a copy of this order in 2:10-md-2187 and it shall apply to each member related case previously transferred to, removed to, or filed in

this district, which includes counsel in all member cases up to and including civil action number 2:14-cv-24632. In cases subsequently filed in this district, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action at the time of filing of the complaint. In cases subsequently removed or transferred to this court, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action upon removal or transfer. It shall be the responsibility of the parties to review and abide by all pretrial orders previously entered by the court.
