
(Plaintiffs' Motion for Leave to Take Supplemental Depositions)

Pending before the court is Plaintiff's Motion for Leave to Take the Supplemental Deposition of Roger Darois and the Deposition of Dan LaFever (ECF No. 559). This motion was filed in each of the relevant bellwether cases, and the court has entered its ruling on the matter by order entered in those civil actions. Therefore, the court adopts its prior ruling and **DENIES** this Motion as moot.

The court **DIRECTS** the Clerk to file a copy of this order in 2:10-md-2187 and it shall apply to each member related case previously transferred to, removed to, or filed in this district, which includes counsel in all member cases up to and including civil action number 2:13-cv-10582. In cases subsequently filed in this district, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action at the time of filing of the complaint. In cases subsequently removed or transferred to this court, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action upon removal or transfer. It shall be the responsibility of the parties to review and abide by all pretrial orders previously entered
