
PRETRIAL ORDER # 5
(Order Rescheduling Initial Conference)

It is **ORDERED** that the initial conference in this matter originally scheduled for March 6, 2014 is rescheduled to **Thursday, May 8, 2014, at 3:00 p.m.** in Judge Joseph R. In cases subsequently filed in this district, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action at the time of filing of the complaint. In cases subsequently removed or transferred to this court, a copy of the most recent

pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action upon removal or transfer. It shall be the responsibility of the parties to review and abide by all pretrial orders previously entered by the court.
