IN RE: IN THE MATTER OF TRANSCRIPT FEE RATES

O R D E R

By action of the Judicial Conference of the United States at its meeting held September 2002, new maximum rates for transcripts prepared by official court reporters were authorized, subject to the approval and order of each district court.

This court being of the opinion that such new maximum authorized rates should be made effective as of March 14, 2003, the date of the director's memorandum implementing the increase in transcript fees, it is ORDERED that official court reporters may charge, subject to the limitation aforesaid, the following rates:

<u>Ordinary Transcript</u> A transcript to be delivered within thirty (30) calendar days after receipt of an order.	\$3.30	\$.83	\$.55
<u>Expedited Transcript</u> A transcript to be delivered within seven (7) calendar days after receipt of an order.	4.40	.83	.55

<u>Daily Transcript</u>			
A transcript to be delivered following adjournment and prior to the normal opening hour of the court on the following morning whether or not it actually is a court day.	5.50	1.10	.83
<u>Hourly Transcript</u>			
A transcript of proceedings ordered under unusual circumstances to be delivered within two (2) hours.	6.60	1.10	.83
<u>Realtime Transcript</u>			
A draft unedited transcript produced by a certified realtime reporter as a byproduct of realtime to be delivered electronically during proceedings or immediately following adjournment.	2.75	1.10	


Orders for transcripts heretofore given, or heretofore authorized either orally or in writing, shall be billed at the rate prevailing prior to the entry of this order.




