**PRETRIAL ORDER #32**  
(Selection of Discovery Group 1)


In accordance with the procedures outlined in PTO # 8, section 3.c. and PTO # 25, each of the parties submitted to the court a list of eight proposed cases for individual discovery and associated memoranda. The court has reviewed the submissions and **ORDERS** that the following cases are selected to constitute the initial cases in Discovery Group 1:

- Donna Cisson et al., v. C.R. Bard 2-11-cv-00195
- Linda Rizzo et al., v. C.R. Bard 2-10-cv-01224
- Wanda Queen et al., v. C.R. Bard 2-11-cv-00012
- Nancy Smith et al., v. C.R. Bard 2-10-cv-01355
- Carolyn Jones et al., v. C.R. Bard , 2-11-cv-00114

It is the court's intention to select additional cases for individual discovery which will include plaintiffs implanted with products beyond the three generations of Avaulta products. This will allow the parties and the court to consider a spectrum of cases representative of the broader inventory of products now included in MDL 2187.

The court **DIRECTS** the Clerk to file a copy of this order in 2-10-md-2187 and it shall apply to each member Avaulta-related case previously transferred to, removed to, or filed in the is district, which includes counsel in all member cases up to and including civil action number 2-12-cv-00977. In cases subsequently filed in this district, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action at the time of filing of the complaint. In cases subsequently removed or transferred to this court, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action upon removal or transfer. It shall be the responsibility of the parties to review and abide by all pretrial orders previously entered by the court.
