Jan Matulka was a Czech-American modern artist originally from Bohemia. Matulka's style would range from Abstract expressionism to landscapes, sometimes in the same day.

In the 1920s Matulka maintained two studios, frequently traveling to and fro from Paris to New York City. Around the middle of the decade Matulka began painting landscapes, as well as abstract pieces. This landscape is in the Modernist style and is typical of his work in that period.
