The temporary law clerks will work primarily on mass tort cases currently assigned to Judge Goodwin.

**Qualifications:**

Applicants must be law school graduates in the top 30% of their class if the school ranks and possess strong writing skills. Work experience, including previous clerkship experience, is welcomed, but not required.
