
IN RE: APPOINTMENT OF THE DISTRICT BENCH AND BAR
VISITING ATTORNEY FEE/NON-APPROPRIATED FUNDS COMMITTEE

GENERAL ORDER

The General Order and Plan for the Administration and Operation of the District and Bankruptcy Court Visiting Attorney Fee/Non-Appropriated Funds, amended and adopted by the Court on March 26, 2013, Section 3.2, authorizes the creation of an advisory committee to advise the Court and its custodian on the matters of policy in the administration of the fund, one for District and one for Bankruptcy.¹

District Court Committee member Teresa L. Deppner, Clerk of Court, retired from Government service on September 1, 2017. The Court hereby appoints Ted J. Philyaw, Acting Clerk of Court, to the District Bench and Bar Committee in Teresa L. Deppner's place and stead.
