

It is accordingly ORDERED that Section II, Item 9(a) in this District's Plan for Prompt Disposition of Criminal Cases be amended to read as follows:


- (a) Time Limit. A defendant shall ordinarily be sentenced within 60 days of the date of his conviction or plea of guilty or nolo contendere.




