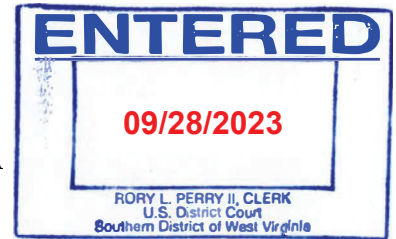

IN RE: IN THE MATTER OF TRANSCRIPT FEE RATES

AMENDED ORDER

At its September 2022 session, the Judicial Conference of the United States approved an increase to the maximum page per original and copy transcript fee rates for fiscal year 2024, effective October 1, 2023. By Order entered on September 15, 2023, this court published the newly effective rates. Thereafter, on September 19, 2023, the Administrative Office advised that the Judicial Conference had approved significant changes to the transcript category names at its September 2023 session.

Accordingly, the Court's prior Order is amended and the following Schedule of Maximum Transcript Rates for all categories of transcript for fiscal year 2024 is as follows:

MAXIMUM TRANSCRIPT RATES			
	Original	First Copy to Each Party	Each Add'l Copy to the Same Party
30-Day Transcript (Ordinary) A transcript to be delivered within thirty (30) calendar days after receipt of an order.	\$4.00	\$1.00	\$0.70
14-Day Transcript A transcript to be delivered within fourteen (14) calendar days after receipt of an order.	\$4.70	\$1.00	\$0.70
7-Day Transcript (Expedited) A transcript to be delivered within seven (7) calendar days after receipt of an order.	\$5.35	\$1.00	\$0.70
3-Day Transcript A transcript to be delivered within three (3) calendar days after receipt of an order.	\$6.00	\$1.20	\$0.85
Next-Day Transcript (Daily) A transcript to be delivered on the calendar day following receipt of the order (regardless of whether that calendar day is a weekend or holiday) before the normal operating hour of the clerk's office.	\$6.70	\$1.35	\$1.00

MAXIMUM TRANSCRIPT RATES			
	Original	First Copy to Each Party	Each Add'l Copy to the Same Party
2-Hour Transcript (Hourly) A transcript of proceedings to be delivered within two (2) hours from receipt of the order.	\$8.00	\$1.35	\$1.00
Realtime Translation A draft unedited transcript produced by a certified realtime reporter as a byproduct of realtime to be delivered electronically during proceedings or immediately following receipt of the order. Orders placed on or before the day of the proceeding will be batched together for purposes of determining the number of fees; and subsequent orders will be charged at the lowest page rate assessed on the previous orders.	One feed ¹ , \$3.40 per page; two-to-four feeds, \$2.35 per page; five or more fees, \$1.65 per page.	n/a	n/a

The Clerk of Court shall forward certified copies of this Order to the Administrative Office of the United States District Courts and all official court reporters in the Southern District of West Virginia, as well as to the Clerk's Offices of the various divisions within the Southern District of West Virginia.

¹ A realtime "fee" is the electronic data flow from the court reporter to the computer of each person or party ordering and receiving the realtime transcription in the courtroom.
