GENERAL ORDER

Effective that same day as the resignation of the Chief United States Bankruptcy Judge for this District, it is **ORDERED**:

- (1) That Rules 83.6(d)(1) (first sentence) and 83.13, Local Rules of Procedure for the Southern District of West Virginia, be, and hereby are, **SUSPENDED**;
- (2) That the reference pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(a) of all proceedings arising under title 11, or arising in or related to cases under title 11, now or hereafter pending in this District, being all of those cases over which the District Court exercises or will hereafter exercise original or removal jurisdiction under 28 U.S.C. § 1334 or 28 U.S.C. § 1452, whether by original filing, removal, transfer, or any other means, be, and hereby is, **WITHDRAWN**, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(d) for cause shown, namely, the vacancy created by the aforementioned resignation.
- (3) That all of those proceedings and cases that are or will fall within the terms of paragraphs (1) and (2) above be, and hereby are, **ASSIGNED** to the docket of the Honorable Frank W. Volk, United States District Judge.

This General Order shall continue in full force and effect until the appointment of a successor Chief United States Bankruptcy Judge for this District by the United States Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit. On that same appointment date, the Local Rules referenced in paragraph (1) above are deemed fully restored, and those proceedings and cases referred to in paragraph (3) are **REFERRED to** the successor Chief United States Bankruptcy Judge without the necessity of a further General Order.
