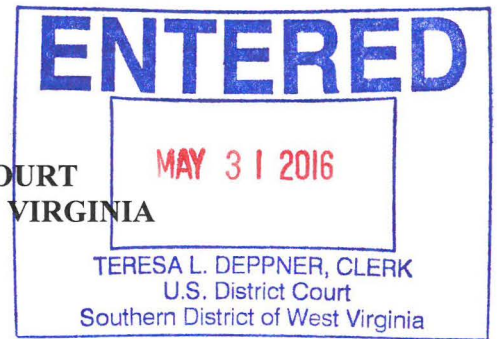

STANDING ORDER



**RE: REFERENCE OF CERTAIN PETITIONS FILED UNDER
JOHNSON V. UNITED STATES, 135 S. Ct. 2551 (2015) TO
MAGISTRATE JUDGE DWANE L. TINSLEY**

Pursuant to the provisions of the Criminal Justice Act, Title 18, U.S.C. §3006A(a)(1) and (c), and because of the need to efficiently process the review of cases under *Johnson v. United States*, 135 S. Ct. 2551 (2015), and where Orders were previously entered appointing the Federal Public Defender for the Southern District of West Virginia or W. Michael Frazier, a CJA Panel Attorney, to represent certain defendants, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the Clerk refer said counseled cases under *Johnson* to the Honorable Dwane L. Tinsley, United States Magistrate Judge, for total pretrial management and submission of proposed findings of fact and recommendation for disposition.

Matters filed under 28 U.S.C. §§ 2255 or 2241 in light of *Johnson* that were referred at the time of filing to Magistrate Judge Cheryl A. Eifert or Magistrate Judge Omar J. Aboulhosn, pursuant to the Court's Standing Order In Re: Assignment and Referral of Civil Actions and Matters to Magistrate Judges entered January 4, 2016, shall be re-referred to Magistrate Judge Dwane L. Tinsley upon entry of any future Order appointing the Federal Public Defender or a CJA Panel Attorney.

The Clerk is directed to place a copy of this Order in every civil or criminal case filed to date or in the future under *Johnson v. United States* and where the Court has appointed the Federal Public Defender or a CJA Panel Attorney.

The Clerk is also directed to send a certified copy of this Order to the United States Attorney, the Federal Public Defender, the Chief Probation Officer and to each Magistrate Judge in this District.
