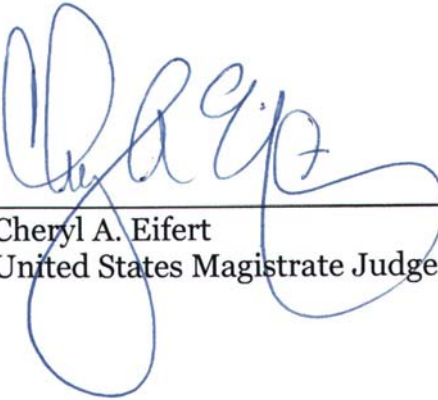
(Defendant's Emergency Motion for Protective Order Precluding or Limiting and Rescheduling Plaintiffs' Deposition of John Weiland and Defendant's Emergency Motion for Protective Order Limiting Plaintiffs' First Requests for Production of Documents to John Weiland in Conjunction with Deposition)

Pending before the court are Defendant C. R. Bard, Inc.'s Emergency Motion for Protective Order Precluding or Limiting and Rescheduling Plaintiffs' Deposition of John Weiland, (ECF No. 901), Defendant C.R. Bard, Inc.'s Emergency Motion for Protective Order Limiting Plaintiffs' First Requests for Production of Documents to John Weiland in Conjunction with Deposition, (ECF No. 903), and Defendant C.R. Bard, Inc.'s Request for Oral Argument (ECF No. 905). The court hereby **GRANTS** the Request for Oral Argument. Accordingly, it is hereby **ORDERED** that a hearing on said motions shall take place before the undersigned United States Magistrate Judge on **Thursday, June 19, 2014 at 2:00 p.m., at Courtroom 102, Sidney L. In cases subsequently filed in this district, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action at the time of filing of the complaint. In cases subsequently removed or transferred to this court, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action upon removal or transfer. It shall be the responsibility of the parties to review and abide by all pretrial orders previously entered by the court.
