**PRETRIAL ORDER # 152
(Order on Plaintiffs' Emergency Motion to Modify Pretrial Order # 131 and Pretrial
Order # 142 and for Expedited Hearing)**

Pending is Plaintiffs' Emergency Motion to Modify Pretrial Order # 131 and Pretrial Order # 142 and for Expedited Hearing, filed November 19, 2014. [Docket 1230]. For the reasons stated on the record at the hearing on this motion on December 9, 2014, it is **ORDERED** that the Emergency Motion to Modify Pretrial Order # 131 and Pretrial Order # 142 is **GRANTED in part** and **DENIED in part**. Plaintiffs' Motion for Expedited Hearing is **DENIED** as moot. I have entered a separate PTO today addressing the scheduling deadlines in the Wave 3 cases in light of my rulings on the record.

The court **DIRECTS** the Clerk to file a copy of this order in 2:10-md-02187 and **in all Wave 3 cases** and it shall apply to each member related case previously transferred to, removed to, or filed in this district, which includes counsel in all member cases up to and including civil action number 2:14-cv-28746. In cases subsequently filed in this district, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action at the time of filing of the complaint. In cases subsequently removed or transferred to this court, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the clerk to counsel appearing in each new action upon removal or transfer. It shall be the responsibility of the parties to review and abide

by all pretrial orders previously entered by the court. The orders may be accessed through the CM/ECF system or the court's website at www.wvsd.uscourts.gov.
