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**PRETRIAL ORDER # 180  
(Order Re: Qualified Settlement Fund-  
Covidien LP & Blasingame, Burch, Garrard & Ashley P.C.)**

Pending is an Unopposed Motion for Approval of Qualified Settlement Fund, filed June 23, 2015. [Docket 1594]. Blasingame, Burch, Garrard & Ashley, P.C. (“BBGA”), as counsel for certain plaintiffs in this MDL No. 2187 has moved the Court for entry of an Order to aid in the efficient processing and administration of a Confidential Master Settlement Agreement (the “Settlement Agreement”) between Defendant Covidien LP and its parent and subsidiary companies (“Covidien”) and BBGA to resolve the claims of certain claimants against Covidien relating to the implant of Covidien Pelvic Repair Products (as defined in the Settlement Agreement). In particular, BBGA’s Motion seeks an Order (1) approving an Escrow Agreement (the “Escrow Agreement”) which forms a settlement escrow account (the “Settlement Escrow”), (2) retaining continuing jurisdiction and supervision over the Settlement Escrow, and (3) determining that the Settlement Escrow constitutes a “qualified settlement fund” within the meaning of section 468B of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the “Code”) and Treasury Regulation sections 1.468B-1, *et. seq.*

The Court, having reviewed the Motion and Escrow Agreement, and finding good and sufficient cause, **FINDS** and **ORDERS** the following:


- 1) The terms of the Escrow Agreement are hereby approved;

2) The Settlement Escrow constitutes a qualified settlement fund within the meaning of section 468B of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (“the Code”) and Treasury Regulation sections 1.468B-1, *et. seq.* The Court further retains continuing jurisdiction and supervision over the Settlement Escrow, in accordance with the terms of the Escrow Agreement; and

3) The appointment of Wells Fargo National Bank to serve as the escrow agent (“Escrow Agent”) pursuant to the Escrow Agreement is approved. The Escrow Agent shall administer the Settlement Escrow in accordance with the terms of the Escrow Agreement. Further, the funds held by the Escrow Agent in the Settlement Escrow shall be disbursed by the Escrow Agent only pursuant to and in conformance with the terms of the Escrow Agreement and Settlement Agreement, which include provisions for payments into the MDL No. 2187 Fund.

The court **DIRECTS** the Clerk to file a copy of this order in 2:10-md-2187 and it shall apply to each member related case previously transferred to, removed to, or filed in this district *where applicable*, which includes counsel in all member cases up to and including civil action number 2:15-cv-08152. In cases subsequently filed in this district, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action at the time of filing of the complaint. In cases subsequently removed or transferred to this court, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the clerk to counsel appearing in each new action upon removal or transfer. It shall be the responsibility of the parties to review and abide by all pretrial orders previously entered by the court.
