
**PRETRIAL ORDER # 243
(Third Amended Docket Control Order – Wave 4 Cases)**

Exhibit A attached to PTO # 236 (Docket Control Order – Wave 4 Cases) identified cases now known as the Bard Wave 4 cases. In subsequent PTOs (PTO ##s 237 and 239), I removed certain cases from Bard Wave 4. The court **ORDERS** that Exhibit A is clarified as to case number 2:14-cv-06478. The plaintiff in that case, Pamela Wright, is incorrectly referred to on Exhibit A as “Brenda Wright” (another Bard MDL plaintiff, civil action number 2:13-cv-25002). The case of *Pamela Wright, et al. v. C. R. Bard, Inc.*, 2:14-cv-06478, is a Bard Wave 4 case. The case of *Brenda Wright, et al., v. C. R. Bard, Inc., et al.*, 2:13-cv-25002, is not.

The court **DIRECTS** the Clerk to file a copy of this order in 2:10-md-2187 and in the Bard Wave 4 cases. In cases subsequently filed in this district after 2:17-cv-01414, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action at the time of filing of the complaint. In cases subsequently removed or transferred to this court, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action upon removal or transfer. It shall be the responsibility of the parties to review and abide by

all pretrial orders previously entered by the court. The orders may be accessed through the CM/ECF system or the court's website at www.wvsd.uscourts.gov.
