**PRETRIAL ORDER # 269  
(Amended Order Scheduling Status Conference and Meeting in MDL 2187  
On December 18, 2017)**

By Pretrial Order (“PTO”) # 267, I scheduled a status conference and meeting in MDL 2187. For reasons appearing to the court, it is **ORDERED** that


- (1) The in chambers meeting scheduled on **Monday, December 18, 2017** will now begin at **11:00 a.m.** instead of 2:00 p.m.; and,
- (2) The Status Conference will begin at **11:30 a.m.** or immediately after the in chambers meeting instead of the previously scheduled 1:30 p.m. time.

It is **ORDERED** that (1) defendant C. R. Bard, Inc.’s client representative(s) with full authority to make all decisions related to MDL 2187; (2) in house counsel for defendant C. R. Bard, Inc. with full authority to make all decisions related to MDL 2187; (3) settlement counsel (if any) for defendant C. R. Bard, Inc.; and (4) lead counsel for plaintiffs and defendant C. R. Bard attend the meeting and status conference.

The court **DIRECTS** the Clerk to file a copy of this order in 2:10-md-2187 and it shall apply to each member related case previously transferred to, removed to, or filed in this district, which includes counsel in all member cases up to and including civil action number 2:17-cv-04483. In cases subsequently filed in this district, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be

provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action at the time of filing of the complaint. In cases subsequently removed or transferred to this court, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action upon removal or transfer. It shall be the responsibility of the parties to review and abide by all pretrial orders previously entered by the court.
