
PRETRIAL ORDER #217
(Motion to Quash and for Protective Order by Non-Parties AkinMears, G.P.
and Amir Shenaq)

Pending before the court is Non-Parties AkinMears, G.P.'S and Amir Shenaq's Combined Objections to American Medical Systems, Inc.'s Subpoenas to Testify at a Deposition in a Civil Litigation and Exhibit A to Subpoena Directed to AkinMears, G.P. and Amir Shenaq; Motion to Quash Said Subpoenas; and Motion for Protective Order (ECF No. 2204). In view of the parties' representation that the discovery dispute has been resolved as set forth in the Stipulation and Agreed Order entered on June 22, 2016, (ECF No. 2405), it is hereby **ORDERED** that the Motion to Quash Subpoenas and for Protective Order is **DENIED** as moot. It is further **ORDERED** that the telephonic hearing scheduled to take place on Friday, June 24, 2016 at 1:30 p.m. **as it pertains to** Non-Parties AkinMears, G.P. and Amir Shenaq's Motion to Compel and for Protective Order **is CANCELED**.

The court **DIRECTS** the Clerk to file a copy of this order in 2:12-md-2325 and it shall apply to each member related case previously transferred to, removed to, or filed in

this district, which includes counsel in all member cases up to and including civil action number 2:16-cv-5567. In cases subsequently filed in this district, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action at the time of filing of the complaint. In cases subsequently removed or transferred to this court, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action upon removal or transfer. It shall be the responsibility of the parties to review and abide by all pretrial orders previously entered by the court.
