
**PRETRIAL ORDER # 227**  
(Emergency Motion to Stay Non-Party Depositions)

Pending before the court is the Emergency Motion to Stay Non-Party Depositions filed by non-parties, Surgical Assistance, Inc., and Medical Funding Consultants, LLC. (ECF No. 2935). Based upon the court's ruling as set forth in PTO #226, (ECF No. 3262), the court **DENIES** the Emergency Motion to Stay Non-Party Depositions. It is so **ORDERED**.

The court **DIRECTS** the Clerk to file a copy of this order in 2:12-md-2325 and it shall apply to each member related case previously transferred to, removed to, or filed in this district, which includes counsel in all member cases up to and including civil action number 2:16-cv-10911. In cases subsequently removed or transferred to this court, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action upon removal or transfer. It shall be the responsibility of the parties to review and abide by all pretrial orders previously entered by the court. The
