
PRETRIAL ORDER # 228
(Motions by Non-Parties to Quash and for Protective Orders)

Pending before the court are the Non-Party AkinMears, G.P.'s Objections to American Medical Systems, Inc.'s Subpoenas to Testify at a Deposition in a Civil Litigation and Exhibit A to Subpoena Directed to AkinMears, G.P.; Motion to Quash Said Subpoena; and Motion for Protective Order, (ECF No. 2917), and Non-Parties Sigma Law Firm LLP, Alpha Law LLP, The Law Offices of Albert J. Lazo, P.A., Martindale Voight LLP, and Pegasus Law LLP, Law Firm Headquarters, LLC, Michael Chhabra, Vincent Chhabra, and Ronald Lasorsa, Motion to Quash Subpoenas Issued by American Medical Systems, Inc., and for a Protective Order, (ECF No. 2205). It is hereby **ORDERED** that a telephonic hearing on said Motions shall take place on **Friday, December 2, 2016** at **2:00 p.m. EST**, before the undersigned United States Magistrate Judge. The number required to connect to the telephonic hearing has previously been provided to counsel by the court.

The court **DIRECTS** the Clerk to file a copy of this order in 2:12-md-2325 and it shall apply to each member related case previously transferred to, removed to, or filed in

this district, which includes counsel in all member cases up to and including civil action number 2:16-cv-10954. In cases subsequently filed in this district, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action at the time of filing of the complaint. In cases subsequently removed or transferred to this court, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action upon removal or transfer. It shall be the responsibility of the parties to review and abide by all pretrial orders previously entered by the court.
