## PRETRIAL ORDER # 51 (AGREED ORDER RE: PLAINTIFFS' MOTION TO COMPEL AMS TO PRODUCE DOCUMENTS [ECF 466])

- 1. On February 14, 2013, Plaintiffs filed their Motion to Compel Production of Documents. (ECF Nos. 466-467)
- 2. Defendants filed their opposition on February 28, 2013. (ECF No. 486)
- 3. Counsel for Plaintiffs and Counsel for Defendant American Medical Systems (AMS) have met and conferred and resolved the disputed issues, rendering the Motion to Compel moot. Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** that Plaintiffs' Motion is **DENIED** as moot.

The parties agree as follows:

- 4. At Plaintiffs' request, AMS produced an interim cross-reference index identifying documents produced in the MDL that were also previously produced in *Ambroff* and *Boatman-Morse*. The index identifies documents with an *Ambroff* production range and corresponding MDL bates numbers. AMS agrees to produce a final index when production is complete.
- 5. At Plaintiffs' request, AMS produced a list of video and audio files produced to date identifying the title of video/audio, date of video/audio and corresponding Bates number on February 27, 2013. At Plaintiffs' request, AMS agrees to supplement and update this list as document production continues.
- 6. At Plaintiffs' request, AMS agrees to supply new load files to provide metadata for attachments related to lab notebooks and document and pages on March 4, 2013.
- 7. AMS and Plaintiffs will meet and confer regarding the appearance of redactions.
- 8. AMS will replace the following production sets due to a vendor error, October 16, 2012 (MDL AMS D0120086-MDL AMS D0244954) and November 30, 2012 (MDL AMS D0806637-MDL AMS D1010044), and will provide a cross-reference index by March 4, 2013. AMS and Plaintiffs have agreed to discuss the costs Plaintiffs might incur as a result of this vendor error and will meet and confer after March 4 if necessary.

9. At Plaintiffs' request, AMS agrees to provide a supplemental separate metadata field with file names, including for e-documents on March 8, 2013.
