(**Revised** Short Form Complaint and Amended Short Form Complaint re: Removal of Coloplast and Endo entities)

I recently entered two PTOs dismissing without prejudice Endo Pharmaceuticals Inc., American Medical Systems Holdings, Inc. and Endo Health Solutions Inc. (collectively referred to as the "Endo Entities") and Coloplast A/S, Coloplast Manufacturing US, LLC, and Porges S.A. In these PTOs, I indicated that I would enter revised Short Form and Amended Short Form Complaints. As a result, attached are a **revised** (1) Short Form Complaint (Exhibit A); and a **revised** (2) Amended Short Form Complaint (Exhibit B) that reflect the removal of these entities from the Short Form and Amended Short Form Complaints in this MDL.

It is **ORDERED** as follows:

(1) While PTO ##s 17, 31, and 35 remain in force and effect where applicable, parties filing Short Form Complaints in new cases or Amended Short Form Complaints in existing cases, where appropriate, must use the revised forms attached to this PTO and located on the court's website beginning no later than June 5, 2013.

The court **DIRECTS** the Clerk to file a copy of this order in 2:12-md-2325 and it shall apply to each member related case previously transferred to, removed to, or filed in this district, which includes counsel in all member cases up to and including civil action number 2:13-cv-12123. In cases subsequently filed in this district, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action at the time of filing of the complaint. In cases subsequently removed or transferred to this court, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action upon removal or transfer. It shall be the responsibility of the parties to review and abide by all pretrial orders previously entered by the court.
