(Plaintiffs' Emergency Motion to Compel and Boston Scientific Corporation's Motion for Entry of Protective Order and to Quash)

Currently pending is Plaintiffs' Emergency Motion to Compel Boston Scientific Corporation to Go Forward with the Deposition of Its Designated Rule 30(B)(6) Witness as Scheduled on March 10-11, 2015, (ECF No. 1058), and Boston Scientific Corporation's Motion for Entry of Protective Order and to Quash. (ECF No. 1059). On March 4, 2015, at the request of the parties, the court heard oral argument on the motions, and determined further briefing was not required. Having considered the arguments of counsel, the court **GRANTS** Plaintiffs' Emergency Motion to Compel Boston Scientific Corporation to Go Forward with the Deposition of Its Designated Rule 30(B)(6) Witness as Scheduled on March 10-11, 2015. For the reasons stated during the hearing, the court **DENIES** Boston Scientific Corporation's Motion for Entry of Protective Order and to Quash. It is hereby **ORDERED** that the deposition of Janice Conner will proceed next week as scheduled. It is further **ORDERED** that the deposition of Mr. Newell shall take place during the week of March 23, 2015 on a date that is convenient for Plaintiffs.

The court **DIRECTS** the Clerk to file a copy of this order in 2:12-md-2326, and it shall apply to each member related case previously transferred to, removed to, or filed in this district, which includes counsel in all member cases up to and including civil action number 2:15-cv-02618. In cases subsequently filed in this district, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action at the time of filing of the complaint. In cases subsequently removed or transferred to this court, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action upon removal or transfer. It shall be the responsibility of the parties to review and abide by all pretrial orders previously entered by the court.
