PRETRIAL ORDER # 145
(Order re: BSC Wave 3 Cases)


Recently, I requested that the parties provide case information for the development of a third wave of cases in this MDL. Specifically, I asked that they provide the 200 oldest cases not already in Wave 1 or 2 (or properly omitted from Wave 1 or 2) where Boston Scientific Corporation (“BSC”) is the only defendant named. The parties complied with my request and provided the following information on 200 cases: (1) case style; (2) case number; (3) date complaint filed; (4) products for which a claim is alleged; and (5) counsel for plaintiff(s).

It is **ORDERED** that the parties jointly provide the following additional information taken from the most current Short Form Complaint, Amended Short Form Complaint or long form Complaint (by adding to the already submitted excel spreadsheet): (1) date of implant; (2) city and state where implant occurred; (3) plaintiff’s state of residence; and (4) plaintiff’s suggested District Court and Division in which venue would be proper absent direct filing or the District Court and Division from which the case was transferred. The parties are directed to jointly file their submission on or before **April 29, 2016**.

The court **DIRECTS** the Clerk to file a copy of this order in 2:12-md-2326 and it shall apply to each member related case previously transferred to, removed to, or filed in this district, which includes counsel in all member cases up to and including civil action number 2:16-cv-3668.

In cases subsequently filed in this district, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action at the time of filing of the complaint. In cases subsequently removed or transferred to this court, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action upon removal or transfer. It shall be the responsibility of the parties to review and abide by all pretrial orders previously entered by the court. The orders may be accessed through the CM/ECF system or the court's website at www.wvsd.uscourts.gov.
