**PRETRIAL ORDER # 161
(Order re: Wave Case Information)**


The parties have advised the court of a number of substantial settlements in the Boston Scientific MDL. However, to date, thousands of cases remain on the court's docket. Accordingly, the court **ORDERS** that on or before **May 19, 2017**, the parties jointly submit to the court via email, an Excel chart containing the following information (1) on the next oldest 500 cases not already in Waves (or properly omitted from those waves), dismissed or on an Inactive Docket Order where Boston Scientific Corp. ("BSC") is the only defendant named; and (2) on the 500 most recently filed cases not already dismissed or on an Inactive Docket Order where BSC is the only defendant named:

1. Case Style
2. Case Number
3. Date Complaint filed
4. Product(s) for which a claim is alleged (please provide separate columns for each product)
5. Counsel name (abbreviations are acceptable)

The Court **DIRECTS** the Clerk to file a copy of this order in 2:12-md-2326 and it shall apply to each member related case previously transferred to, removed to, or filed in this district, which includes counsel in all member cases up to and including civil action number 2:17-cv-

02788. In cases subsequently filed in this district, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action at the time of filing of the complaint. In cases subsequently removed or transferred to this Court, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action upon removal or transfer. It shall be the responsibility of the parties to review and abide by all pretrial orders previously entered by the Court. The orders may be accessed through the CM/ECF system or the Court's website at www.wvsd.uscourts.gov.
