**PRETRIAL ORDER # 128**

**(Motion to Amend Pretrial Order No. 20 (Waiver of Service for Coloplast Corp.); Revised  
Email Address for Plaintiff Profile Form and Plaintiff Fact Sheet)**

Pending is a Motion to Amend Pretrial Order No. 20 (“PTO # 20”) filed by Defendant Coloplast Corp. (“Coloplast”). [ECF No. 1280]. In the Motion, Coloplast requests that the court amend PTO # 20 to change the email address and firm address where plaintiffs must send the Short Form Complaint and other documents to counsel for Coloplast.

For good cause shown, the court **ORDERS** that Coloplast’s Motion to Amend Pretrial Order No. 20 is **GRANTED**. PTO # 20 shall remain in force and effect, except that plaintiffs shall send the Short Form Complaint, a request for waiver of service pursuant to the provisions of Fed. R. Civ. P. 4 and, if in their possession, a sticker page or other medical record identifying the product at issue in the case by email to Coloplast at [ColoplastSFC@kslaw.com](mailto:ColoplastSFC@kslaw.com); **OR** by U.S. Mail to:


