**PRETRIAL ORDER # 86  
(Fourth Amended Docket Control Order – Wave 1 Cases)**


By PTO # 76 (First Amended Docket Control Order – Wave 1 Cases), I directed the parties to identify cases for the Coloplast Wave 1 work up. The PTO also included scheduling deadlines for Coloplast Wave 1. By PTO # 77 (Second Amended Docket Control Order – Wave 1 Cases), I noted that the parties had advised of substantial progress in settlement efforts and, as a result, more than half of the cases identified for inclusion in Coloplast Wave 1 were in settlement mode with the potential for the remaining cases on the list to move into settlement mode. Therefore, I stayed PTO # 76 until November 23, 2015, and directed the parties to provide an updated list of cases for the Coloplast Wave 1 work up by November 19, 2015. On November 23, 2015, I entered PTO # 80 (Third Amended Docket Control Order – Wave 1 Cases) staying the deadlines in PTO # 77 for 60 days or until January 15, 2016.

The parties have recently represented to the court that they jointly seek an additional stay of the deadlines that have not already passed in PTO # 76 as settlements progress in this MDL. Upon careful consideration, it is **ORDERED** that the deadlines contained in PTO # 76 are stayed until March 15, 2016. If the parties do not continue to make substantial progress in settlement by March 15, 2016, I will lift the stay on the deadlines contained in PTO # 76 that

have not already passed and enter new deadlines for the Plaintiff Fact Sheet (“PFS”) and the Defendant Fact Sheet (“DFS”). The PFSs and DFSs for Coloplast Wave 1 cases will be due shortly after the stay of PTO # 76 is lifted and the PTO has been entered identifying the Coloplast Wave 1 cases. The court **DIRECTS** leadership counsel to submit within thirty days, the proposed PFS and DFS to the court for approval and, for the PFS, posting on the court’s website.

The court **DIRECTS** the Clerk to file a copy of this order in 2:12-md-2387 and in the Wave 1 cases. In cases subsequently filed in this district after 2:16-cv-00257, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action at the time of filing of the complaint. In cases subsequently removed or transferred to this court, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action upon removal or transfer. It shall be the responsibility of the parties to review and abide by all pretrial orders previously entered by the court.
