**PRETRIAL ORDER # 90  
(Fifth Amended Docket Control Order – Wave 1 Cases & General Stay of Discovery)**


By PTO # 76 (First Amended Docket Control Order – Wave 1 Cases), I directed the parties to identify cases for the Coloplast Wave 1 work up. The PTO also included scheduling deadlines for Coloplast Wave 1. By PTO # 77 (Second Amended Docket Control Order – Wave 1 Cases), I noted that the parties had advised of substantial progress in settlement efforts and, as a result, more than half of the cases identified for inclusion in Coloplast Wave 1 were in settlement mode with the potential for the remaining cases on the list to move into settlement mode. Therefore, I stayed PTO # 76 until November 23, 2015, and directed the parties to provide an updated list of cases for the Coloplast Wave 1 work up by November 19, 2015. On November 23, 2015, I entered PTO # 80 (Third Amended Docket Control Order – Wave 1 Cases) staying the deadlines for 60 days or until January 15, 2016. On January 15, 2016, by PTO # 86 (Fourth Amended Docket Control Order – Wave 1 Cases), I stayed the deadlines by another 60 days until March 15, 2016, and directed the parties to submit Plaintiff Fact Sheets and Defendant Fact Sheets. They have done so.

On March 14, 2016, the parties reported to the court that they continue to make very substantial progress in their settlement efforts and requested a stay until April 7, 2016. It is

**ORDERED** that the deadlines originally set forth in PTO # 76 are stayed until **April 7, 2016**, when the court conducts a status conference in this MDL. It is further **ORDERED** that because the Wave 1 cases have not yet been designated, discovery is stayed in all MDL cases that name Coloplast.

The court **DIRECTS** the Clerk to file a copy of this order in 2:12-md-2387. In cases subsequently filed in this district after 2:16-cv-02361, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action at the time of filing of the complaint. In cases subsequently removed or transferred to this court, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action upon removal or transfer. It shall be the responsibility of the parties to review and abide by all pretrial orders previously entered by the court.
