(Order Granting Motion to Amend)


Pending is plaintiffs' Motion to Amend Master Long Form Complaint and Jury Demand, filed December 19, 2013. [Docket 61.] Plaintiffs seek leave to amend their Master Long Form Complaint and Jury Demand to include jurisdictional and venue allegations inadvertently omitted from the original complaint. Defendants do not object.

Pursuant to Rule 15(a)(2) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, it is **ORDERED** that the plaintiffs' Motion to Amend Master Long Form Complaint and Jury Demand is **GRANTED**. The plaintiffs are instructed to file their First Amended Master Long Form Complaint and Jury Demand.

The court **DIRECTS** the Clerk to file a copy of this order in 2:13-md-2440 and it shall apply to each member related case previously transferred to, removed to, or filed in this district, which includes counsel in all member cases up to and including civil action number 2:13-cv-31943. In cases subsequently filed in this district, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action at the time of filing of the complaint. In cases subsequently removed or transferred to this court, a copy of the most recent

pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action upon removal or transfer. It shall be the responsibility of the parties to review and abide by all pretrial orders previously entered by the court.
